Bed Race Rules 2011

THE TEAM

- a) The team shall consist of 4 people (who are at least 16 years old) to propel the bed, and one other person (who is at least 14 years old) on the bed as passenger.
- b) The bed passenger must be at least 14 years old and suitably attired. **Protective headgear must be worn** by the passenger during the Race and sufficient facility to hold on safely must be available on pain of disqualification.
- c) No substitutes will be allowed at any time during the Race.
- d) Except for the nominated passenger, any riding on the bed is strictly forbidden, especially on the downhill parts of the course.
- e) Race competitors must obey instructions from all Race officials (eg starters, timekeepers, marshals etc).
- f) The throwing of missiles or objects of any description is dangerous and is **strictly forbidden at all times** (this includes water bombs, flour, eggs, sweets and anything else that could cause alarm, damage or injury).
- g) There must be no deliberate obstruction of other beds during the Race.
- h) During the Race beds should keep to the left hand side of roads unless overtaking.

THE BED

- a) The bed must have no means of mechanical propulsion.
- b) The bed must not be deliberately run on less than four wheels during the Race.
- c) All bed must have been examined and passed by the scrutinizers prior to the start of the Race.
- d) The bed's wheels must be a minimum 3 inch diameter.
